I. TEAM POLICIES

- A. Appearance:
 - 1. Hair must be kept neat and clean at all times
 - 2. You must have a relatively clean shave every day.
 - Uniforms must be worn neatly at all times.
 - Practice apparel must be worn neatly at all times.
 - Jewelry Is not allowed during games, practices or weights and conditioning.
 - *NOTE: A necklace may be worn if it is not readily visible. 6. Off Field Appearance: Look professional at all times. (no inappropriate advertising)
- B. Tardiness and Absence:

WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!!!! Except for extreme circumstances: If such a circumstance arises, PRIOR DIRECT NOTICE with coaching staff is mandatory.

- Arrive 15 minutes prior to any scheduled event.
- 2. If you are not early you are LATE!!!!
- C. Academics:

IF NOT A STUDENT - WILL NOT BE AN ATHLETE

- Attendance to all classes is mandatory.
- D. Training Room:

ALL Policies and Procedures must be followed.

- A. On Field:

 - c. No Physical Outbursts (Punching, etc)

- 4. Respect (Eye Contact and Attention):
 - a. To Coaches
 - b. Teammates (Captains)
 - c. Umpires
 - d. Opponents
 - e. Fans
 - f. Field-Dugouts-Locker Rooms (kept neat and organized at all times
- 5. NO TALKING TO FANS / FAMILY, etc., BEFORE OR DURING THE GAME. Once we step on the field, we are focused on only one thing.
- B. During Travel (Bus / Hotel)
 - 1. See Appearance
 - 2. Be a Gentleman at all times:
 - a. No profanity
 - b. Represent you and GAITHER well
 - 3. No Alcohol/Drugs
 - 4. Keep hotel rooms neat.
 - 5. Respect curfew.
 - 6. NO Girls in room.
- C. Gaither Campus and Off Campus
 - 1. See Appearance
 - 2. Be a Gentleman (yes sir, no ma'am, etc.)
 - 3. Respect for all that you come in contact with.

Best Practices for Student-Athletes on Social Media

- Make sure your default pictures are appropriate.
- Your Twitter handle and Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat names, and URL should not include profanity.
- Privacy settings only go so far. Social media is public. Always keep that in mind.
- The laws of the real world still apply in the world of social media, i.e.: underage drinking is against the law, harassment, hate crime, cyber bullying, etc.
- Retweeting profanity is no different than using it in your own original tweets. DONT do it!
- · Avoid replying to, or retweeting twitter users with vulgar names.
- Don't allow a hater to bait you into "social beef". Ignore them and remember their actions are usually fueled by jealousy.
- There are many other teams and student- athletes at your school. Take the time to give them a shout-out when they do big things.
- · What happens in the locker room stays there. Things that are said in private team settings should never find their way onto social platforms.
- Don't tweet or post during class. That's like disrespecting someone (in this case your professor) behind his or her back. Always be mindful that professors may be monitoring your social accounts.
- If your coaching staff and/or athletic administrators give you guidelines to follow for social media, be sure to trust and follow them closely. Your team and staff have your long-term best interests in mind.
- Your sports information office and coaches are monitoring your social accounts. Don't be fooled into believing nobody is paying attention.
- Act as a representative of your sport and your team and always maintain a professional profile.

ATTENTION! PLEASE READ! WASH & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Post-embellishment is <u>not</u> recommended for digital uniforms.
- Pre-wash garments. Wash twice at recommended care with detergent before wear.
- Follow care instructions that are permanently affixed to the inside of each garment.
- Wash immediately after wear. Do not allow stains to set.
- Wash white garments separate from colored garments.
- Wash in cold water to avoid colorfastness issues.
- Use oxygenated cleaners, detergent specifically for uniforms/performance fabrics, or mild detergent (<10 ph).
- Do not use chlorine bleach.
- 9. Do not dry clean or iron.
- Do not use fabric softeners.
- Do not soak garments.
- Fasten hook & loop tapes to avoid snagging in wash.
- 13. Do not overload machine. Water level should be higher than garment level
- 14. Do not let wet garments lay on top of one another.
- Inspect garments after wash. If stains have not been removed, wash again. Do not dry until stains are removed.
- Line dry when possible or required.
- Be sure garments are completely dry before storing.
